1. PURPOSE

This policy establishes WEG's obligations for managing international student transfer requests. It ensures compliance with **OS 2.1** (Student information) of the Standards for RTOs 2025, and with ESOS Act 2000 s.47D (transfer restrictions in the first six months) and the January 2026 ESOS Amendment (commission ban for onshore transfers).

2. LEGISLATIVE FRAMEWORK

Standard / Legislation	Relevance
OS 2.1 — Standards for RTOs 2025	Students must be informed of transfer rights before and during enrolment
ESOS Act 2000 s.47D	Restrictions on accepting transfer students in first 6 months of principal course
ESOS NC Std 9 — National Code 2018	Deferral, suspension and cancellation obligations linked to transfers
January 2026 ESOS Amendment	Prohibition on commissions for onshore transfer student recruitment

3. TRANSFER FROM WEG

An international student may request transfer to another CRICOS provider. WEG will assess fairly and without delay. Transfer is granted where it is in the student's best interest, the course better suits their needs, or WEG has failed to

provide contracted services.

4. TRANSFER TO WEG — FIRST 6 MONTHS RESTRICTION

Under ESOS Act 2000 s.47D, WEG will NOT enrol a student who has not completed 6 months of their principal course at another provider, UNLESS: the original provider has ceased to be registered; has ceased to offer the course; has agreed in writing to the transfer; or the student's wellbeing is at risk.

5. JANUARY 2026 AMENDMENT — COMMISSION BAN

WEG will not pay, offer or receive any commission or referral fee for recruiting any international student transferring between CRICOS providers while onshore in Australia. This applies to all education agents and intermediaries.
